- Fully filled out CPI application form
- Insured location(s)
- Turnover
- Loss history
- Recall plan and product traceability

### Limits and Premiums\*

- Up to EUR 25 million depending on coverage, risk and industry
- Minimum premium and deductibles are based upon coverage, risk and industry
